David Bekhazi joined Edelman Middle East in 2019 as a Creative Director with more than 14 years' experience in creating advertising campaigns focusing on concept creation, brand identity, digital campaigns, social media and activation ideas. David has worked with clients across multiple sectors in the region including real estate, travel and tourism, hospitality, government, FMCG, F&B, automotive, entertainment and broadcast.

In his current role in Edelman, David leads the creative activations for Dubai, Abu Dhabi and Riyadh. In alignment with the company's global creative network, he is responsible for concept creation, delivery and execution of client's brand.

Prior to joining Edelman, David worked with various advertising agencies including Publicis Groupe (11 years) and FCB Global (5 years), where he was involved in leading, developing and overseeing creative projects for brands such as, L'Oreal Group, Nivea, Nestle (with all the sub brands), Mondelez Group (Oreo, Cadbury), Renault, Maserati, Dubai South, DIFC (Dubai), Meraas, Coca Cola Arena, Emaar, Dubai Properties Group, Sobha Real Estate, Citibank, and Danone (Aptamil & Bebelac).
